## **Roadworthiness Inspection (RWI) for Uganda**

The Uganda National Bureau of Standards (UNBS) has appointed Autoterminal Japan Ltd.(ATJ) as an accredited service provider for provision of Pre-export Verification of conformity to standards(PVoC) inspection service. ATJ will provide inspections in Japan, United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom, Singapore and South Africa.

UNBS aims to start the Roadworthiness Inspection (RWI) program of used motor vehicles and conformity to standards of other products such as Buses, Vans, Electronic forklifts, Earthmoving equipment, and cranes, effective 20th March 2025. Subsequently, ATJ will commence inspections starting 20th March 2025. We will start accepting Inspection requests from 18th March 2025, onwards.

1. Submit the Uganda Application Form, fill up the blank form either in excel or PDF file which can be found in our ATJ website [www.inspections.jp](http://www.inspections.jp). You can also Download Autoterminal Japan App or register with <https://inspectionsapp.jp/> to send requests online. Application Form can be submitted to ATJ office either by email or fax.
